Bridge Preservation Definition

Actions or strategies that prevent, delay or reduce deterioration of bridges or bridge elements, restore the function of existing bridges, <u>keep bridges in good condition and</u> <u>extend their useful life</u>. Preservation actions may be preventive or condition-driven.
