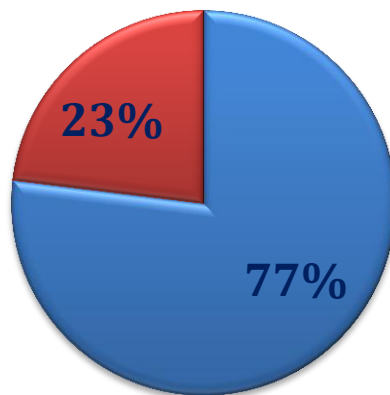


Q1 - Does your agency collect bridge element condition data?

b) If no, how are your bridge preservation needs identified and managed?

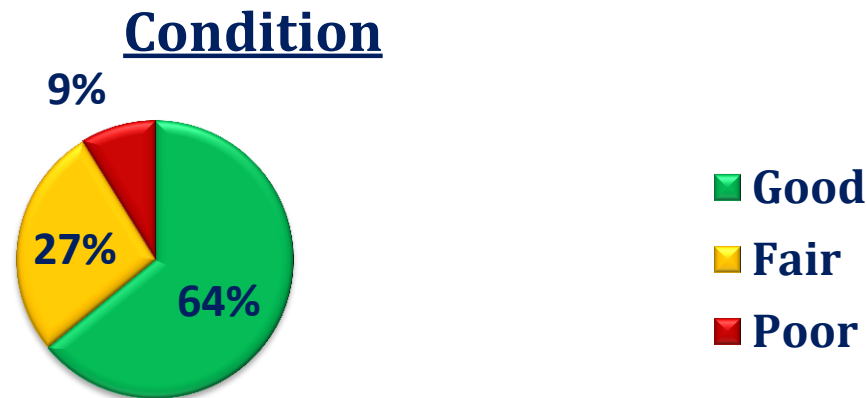

■ Do Not Collect Element Data

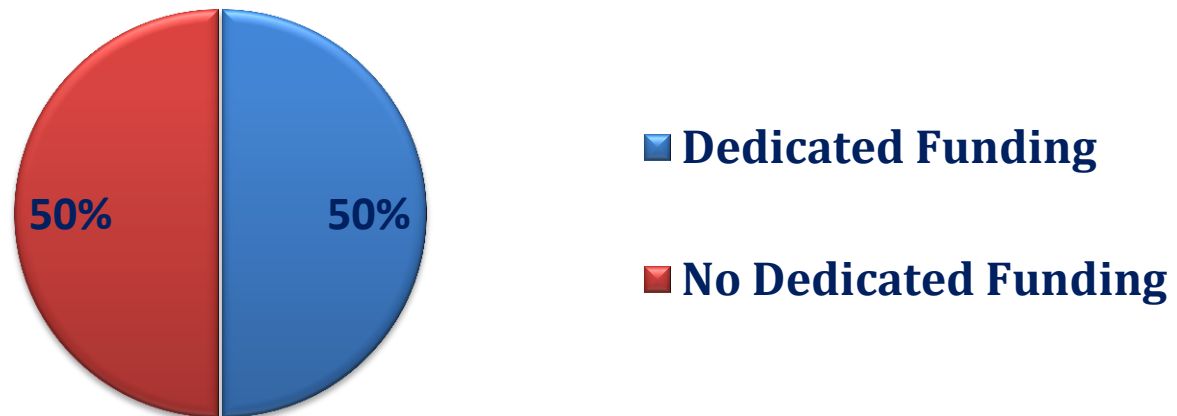
Q2 - If you would to classify your bridge inventory under three categories of Good, Fair, and Poor condition, what percentage of your bridges would fall under each of these categories?



Q3 - How are the bridge preservation (BP) needs funded?

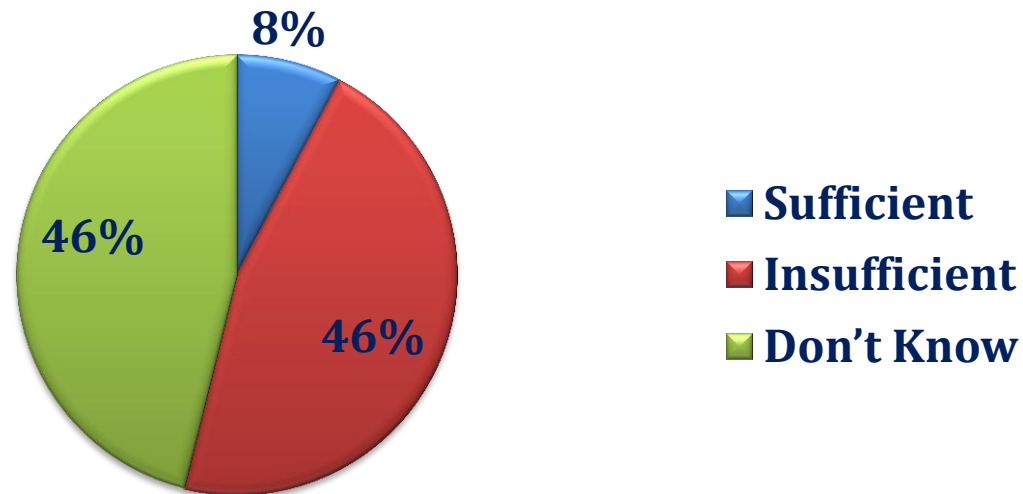
- a) Does your state have a separate program for Bridge Preservation activities?
