Action Item - Research

NCHRP 14-23: Practical Bridge Preservation Actions and Investment Strategies

Completion Date: 3–10–15

Objective: To develop a handbook for possible adoption by AASHTO that will assist state departments of transportation in making bridge preservation investment decisions.

STATUS: The project panel approved the Interim Report No. 1 and the work plan for the remainder of the project. Work is in progress on Phase II of four phases.

Action Item - Research

NCHRP 14-30: Spot Painting to Extend Highway Bridge Coating Life

Objective: to develop guidelines for the selection and use of a broad spectrum of protective materials for spot treatment of failed coatings on steel highway bridges.

STATUS: Proposals have been received in response to the RFP. The panel met in December 2012 and selected a contractor to perform the work.
