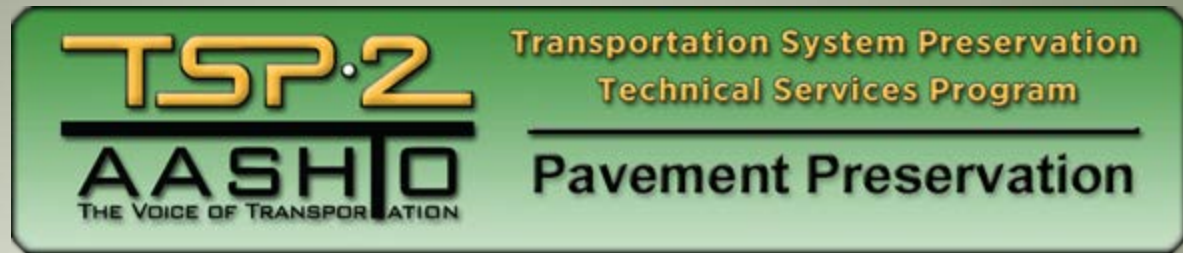

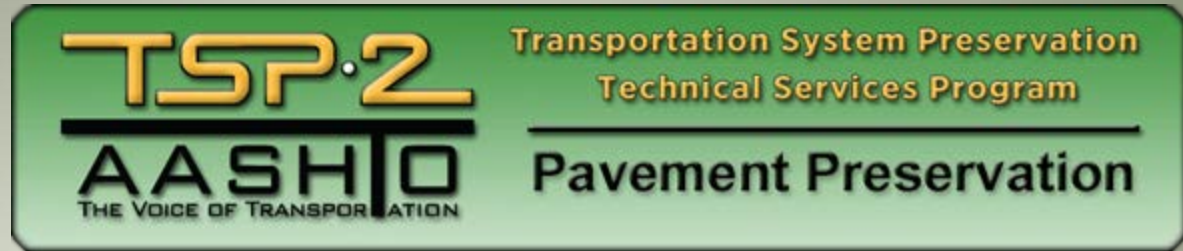

AASHTO Standing Committee on Highways (SCOH)

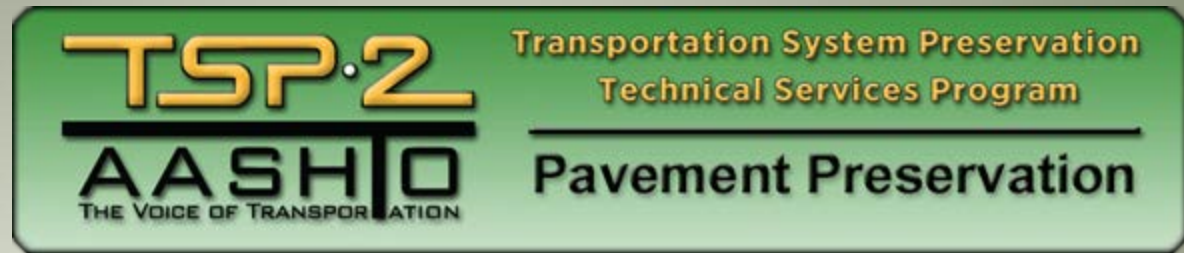
- 47 Dot's participate, largest TSP

- 2010 Bridge Preservation Partnerships

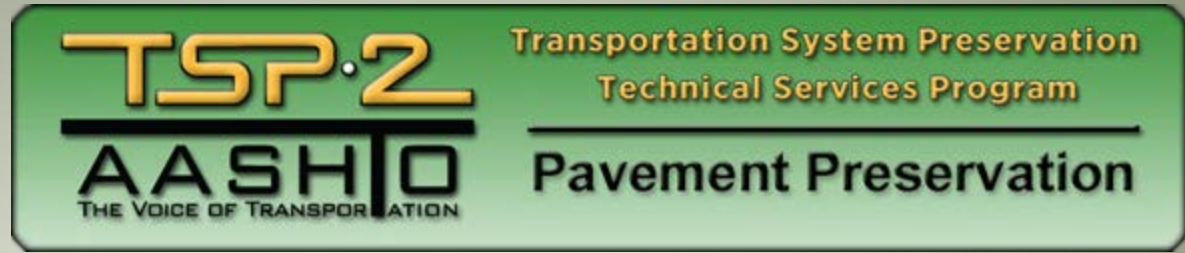

- Quantify and promote the effectiveness of PP



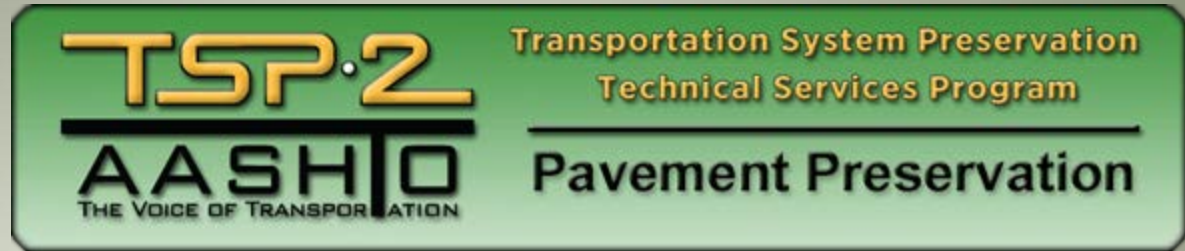
