National Bridge Preservation Conference-2014

- Took place in Orlando, FL from April 21-25, 2014.
- There were 514 Attendees. (42 from FLDOT)
- All but five states were able to attend.
- There were twelve attendees from Local Agencies.
- There was one representative from Canada.
- Regional Partnerships held both Common and Individual Meetings.
- 64 Technical Presentations were made during three concurrently running tracts.
- 24 Live Outdoor Demonstrations were presented.
- 6 Indoor Demonstrations were presented.
- There were 59 National Industry Members that exhibited
